

2023 Part-Time Market Day Manager

<u>BisMarket</u> is seeking an outgoing individual to fill the part-time Market Day Manager position. **Essential Functions:**

- 1. Oversee all market day activities for BisMarket
- 2. Fully understand and able to enforce all Market Rules
- 3. Manage market set up (beginning 8:00 am) and tear down (done around 2:00 pm)
- 4. Coordinate with market day entertainment, kids activities, volunteers, and special events contacts
- 5. Customer relations: manage coupons, promotions, incentives, food donations, answer questions at the information booth
- 6. Social media posts to feature products, vendors, entertainment and other activities the <u>day of</u> <u>the market</u>
- 7. Enforce tobacco-free policy if needed (customers and/or vendors)
- 8. Manage credit/debit/EBT card machine
- 9. Maintain comprehensive understanding of SNAP and Beet Bucks eligible items
- 10. Distribute Beet Bucks and educate customers on their use
- 11. Ensure all vendors understand SNAP and Beet Bucks process
- 12. Drop off any fresh food donations to local shelter/food pantry after market close
- 13. Update Local Foods Coordinator and board of directors with successes and challenges of market days
- 14. Attend monthly board meetings and the Fall Vendor meeting in October.
- 15. Additional duties as deemed necessary
- B. Possible duties may include:
 - 1. Vendor relations: recruitment, email/phone correspondence, record keeping
 - 2. Seek funding sources and/or assist with grant writing for sustainability of markets and market manager position

Qualifications:

- 1. Exceptional organizational skills with attention to detail
- 2. Must possess good computer skills and knowledge of Google suite (Gmail, Calendar, Drive)
- 3. Strong leadership skills and self-motivated
- 4. Knowledge of and passion for local foods and goods
- 5. Excellent communication skills, written and verbal
- 6. Experience working with diverse groups
- 7. Marketing and networking skills
- 8. Efficient and appropriate use of social media
- 9. Management and/or customer service experience preferred

Outdoor working conditions for BisMarket. Light to moderate physical duty; walking, some lifting, standing for extended periods of time. The position is part-time, temporary, contractual. Hours are Saturdays 8am - 2pm, June through October, with potential for minimal hours throughout the week. Approximately 5-8 hours per week. Ability to take 3 Saturdays off with advance notice. Salary range is \$15-\$20 per hour depending on experience. The Market Manager position is 100% grant and community partner funded, with hopes of continued funding. This position is supervised by the Local Foods Coordinator with support from the BisMarket board of directors.
